

Sketch Your Property or Area

Start by making an accurate top view sketch of the areas that need to be watered (see Design Layout Example on page 2). Be sure to add details such as the outline of your home, any retaining walls, sidewalks, paved areas, all the plants, and the water source locations accurately and to scale.

This will require measuring the area. We recommend using graph paper with small squares. This will make drawing to scale easier. Each small square on this manual graph could represent one foot of your property; this scale is usually appropriate for residential landscapes, or you can use 1" graph = 10' of your area.
